Submission of Abstract

Those who wish to present a paper at the Conference are invited to send the abstract to the International Scientific Committee (ISC) of EASTS in English of about 500 words long identifying the topic code number, three key words, and the main idea of the proposed contribution. They are also required to indicate the name(s) of the author(s), his/her (their) affiliation(s), and at least one mailing address with telephone and fax numbers as well as an e-mail address.

As a result of the review, abstracts will be classified into three groups: papers for Journal publication, those for Proceedings publication, and papers to be rejected.

Submission of an abstract through on-the-web "Submission Form of Abstract"(*) is strongly recommended. When your submission is completed, the entry number will be noticed to you by the ISC via e-mail. Selection of Papers

The selection criteria of papers to be included in the Journal follow: papers must be written in English according to the Paper Format for the Journal of EASTS(*); papers should deal with transportation related topics; innovative features of analyses and experiences will be considered in judging paper quality; and well organized practical information and/or statistics together with practical policy/project application will be highly evaluated. If you would like your paper to be evaluated in its practical value, specify it in your abstract. The paper selection procedures for the EASTS Conference will be detailed on the ISC web site (*).
