II. Important Notices


(1) Requirement of Membership of EASTS for Presentation

Those who want to present a paper at the Conference should have an "EASTS Regular Member ID". Any paper submitted without ID cannot be presented at the Conference and will not be included in the Proceedings and Journals, either. If you do not have a Regular Member ID, you are required to apply for a membership to one of the domestic societies of EASTS, to which you (will) belong before submitting the paper. 
(2) Paper Selection

(2-1) Academic Papers



Academic papers submitted to the EAST Conference will be peer-reviewed and selected into EASTS Proceedings, EASTS Journal, or Asian Transport Studies (ATS) Journal. Papers for EASTS Journal and ATS Journal are finally selected from the revised papers. <u>Authors who prefer to be nominated ATS</u> <u>Journal are required to apply to ATS Journal category when you submit your full paper</u>. For your reference, the rate of acceptance to the submitted papers in the previous EASTS Journal and ATS Journal are 35% and 6%, respectively. Best papers will be awarded "EASTS Paper Awards".

(2-2) Practical Papers



Practical papers submitted to the EAST Conference will be peer-reviewed and selected into EASTS Proceedings. Different from academic papers, the review process is simpler. Usefulness, timeliness, reliability, and practical novelty such as on-going transportation projects, recent issues or practical suggestions on transportation policies will be highly evaluated. We strongly recommend the participation of professionals from governments and transportation-related businesses.

(2-3) EASTS Paper Awards

(Paper Awards: Best Paper Awards and YASOSHIMA Yoshinosuke Prize)

Best Paper Awards will be selected from both academic and practical papers that are evaluated to contribute excellently in one or more of the following areas, in addition to standard paper review criteria.

- (a) Enlightening Asia-specific topics
- (b) Discovering interesting facts
- (c) Technological innovation
- (d) Institutional innovation
- (e) Theoretical development
- (f) Methodological development
- (g) Best application in practices
- (h) Difficult research accumulations

EASTS Best Paper Awards will be given to a maximum of 10 selected academic and/or practical papers during the EASTS Conference. YASOSHIMA Yoshinosuke Prize can be given to the most excellent paper, if any, among the above-selected best papers. EASTS Paper Awards will be finally determined during the EASTS Conference.

(3) Publication of Asian Transport Studies (ATS) Journal

"Asian Transport Studies (ATS)" is published in addition to the existing EASTS Journal. It aims at providing useful insights into solving Asia-specific transport-related issues from both theoretical and practical perspectives. It treats all types of transport modes and all issues in transport sector. Even though papers dealing with the Asia-specific issues are especially welcome, other papers related to transportation studies are also within the scope of this journal. Selected papers will be published in one of four issues over two years (Selection method refers to the Paper Selection above). Before publication, English editing services will be provided to each paper for free. EASTS is trying to promote the ATS journal as an internationally well-cited journal in near future. (4) Conference CD-ROM, Proceedings and Journal Publications

Four types of publications will be issued: Conference CD-ROM, EASTS Proceedings (Proceedings of the Eastern Asia Society for Transportation Studies), EASTS Journal (Journal of the Eastern Asia Society for Transportation Studies), and ATS (Asian Transport Studies) Journal. Conference CD-ROM contains all academic and practical papers that are qualified for the Conference presentation, conditional on an advanced registration to the Conference. This CD-ROM will be published before the Conference and directly distributed to participants during the Conference. The other three publications will be issued after the Conference from presented papers at the conference. EASTS proceedings is published on EASTS web site, and EASTS Journal and ATS Journal is published on the J-Stage website.

(5) Financial Support

EASTS provides financial support (conference registration, lowest airfare and accommodation fees) only for the **EASTS regular members** who present Academic Papers or Practical Papers with the excellent review result and belong to the following EASTS member countries/regions/societies: Cambodia, China, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam, and Mongolia. Please note that <u>the prospective beneficiaries are required to submit "Application Form for Financial Support in EASTS 2013 Conference" (available on the EASTS website).</u> Details on eligibility criteria to receive the financial support and amount of support are also available on the EASTS website. The results of selection for the support will be informed after completion of paper review process.
