In 2014, the SCI impact factors for Transportmetrica is 3.773 (papers published till 2012) while “Transportmetrica A: Transport Science” (same as Transportmetrica) is 1.333 counting from 2013 and “Transportmetrica B: Transport Dynamics” is 2.417.

EASTERN ASIA SOCIETY FOR TRANSPORTATION STUDIES NEW ZEALAND

Dear EASTS board members

It is less than a year since we last met and as a result, the activities at the bottom end of East Asia have been limited. This is mainly due to the fact that the past membership had less than a handful of members knowing what EASTS is all about.

Since taking on the EASTS NZ chair from emeritus Professor Chris Kissling in late 2012, I have created an EAST NZ board with the objective of getting EASTS NZ playing a bigger role within EASTS international and in New Zealand. EASTS international (www.easts.info) and EASTS NZ have been operational for many years, however, until now EASTS has really only been known by academics involved in transport, urban planning and logistics and less with the commercial industry. While this is certainly still the case, the last EASTS conference in Taipei in 2013 highlighted the need to link future research and funding to projects that will benefit the population of EASTS countries and thus, enhance the economic and environmental development in a sustainable way of these countries. Until recently many research papers were purely mathematically focused with a low direct application link, so it was good to see that this approach matches well with the philosophy of industry who wish to see more applied research benefiting their business. This is what I have indicated to a number of organisations, asking me why I was promoting EASTS/EASTS NZ - organisations like ASEAN NZ (who have a clear focus on Asia) indicated they would have an interest in cooperation.

I conducted an analysis amongst NZ academics in the field of transportation to see whether they had an interest in becoming EASTS members but most told me that they wish to restrict involvement to Australia, however, would be open to new ideas should they feel any direct benefits in terms of research and new opportunities. The financial aspect of attending EASTS conferences cannot be under-estimated, keeping in mind high airfares, a reason why EASTS/EASTS NZ require more external funding to join EASTS conferences or able to participate to IRG (International Research Group) projects. I also need to highlight that some academics will only get involved if they see direct benefits to their own career – something that is a lot more common in Anglo-Saxon countries than European and perhaps Asian countries. New Zealand has two organisations CILT (Chartered Institute of Logistics and Transport) and IPENZ transport (Institute of Professional Engineers NZ) involved with transportation that also struggle with membership and getting professionals involved. The NZ members who attended an EASTS conference in the past understand my way of thinking a lot better than those who have not so far. Attendance gives a better understanding of the cross-cultural benefits and becomes also an eye opener, especially when it comes to decision-making processes in other cultures – hence I a huge benefit for NZ professionals dealing with Asian countries. The personal relationship building opportunities with professionals from the other EASTS countries is also invaluable. This was my 'marketing campaign'.

Now after a recent radical engagement with EASTS NZ members, I have revitalised the membership and had the offer over the weekend from an international academic teaching at Waikato University to help look after the academic connections here in NZ, as the past academic involved indicated he had not sufficient time to

create momentum. The board agreed to take up the offer and welcomes Dr Abraham Zhang to support EASTS NZ.

It became obvious that we need to look at getting industry more involved with international trade and also opportunities to share our expertise with other EASTS societies. With a current membership of less than 20 people who are involved in many other organisations, it is important to re-focus on a regular basis on the members, their views and interests as well as perceived benefits. While those who attended past conferences will properly understand the benefits of belonging to EASTS, keeping in mind that the recent conferences included keynote speakers from the World Bank, the Asian Development Bank (ADB), GIZ (German Internationale Zusammenarbeit – past GTZ) and other relevant players which gave EASTS a much deserved higher profile. In accordance with the increase of Free Trade Agreements coming into place, it would be great for EASTS to play a greater role in the future and become a platform between academia and industry. Topics like disaster management, border control, security and communications in transport may become areas EASTS may wish to focus on in the future as these research topics may attract funding and prestige. These topics are strongly related to transportation and with free trade agreements on the increase, countries will automatically be confronted with security and border control issues. These could lead to excellent IRG (International Research Groups) projects, funded in a different way to the current \$ allocation.

In terms of other tangible activities, EASTS NZ conducted a consultation process amongst NZ transport professionals in late 2014 to outline two infrastructure projects for the EASTS book. The AUCKLAND VIADUCT and the CHRISTCHURCH INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT were chosen and prepared for EASTS secretariat. Hence again it was interesting to see the disconnection of industry and academia, at least here in New Zealand.

EASTS NZ encouraged its members to put academic papers towards the CEBU conference but this was not a success as a result of the academic coordinator not sufficiently committed. This will hopefully change with the newly appointed academic member.

EASTS NZ contributed towards the Outstanding Project Award (chaired by EASTS Malaysia) through a project run by Walter Glass who is a new EASTS member. Walter has been successfully running an aid project for the recent Vanuatu disaster.

The EASTS NZ IRG project on livestock transport has not been extended to other countries at this stage as the financial contribution of EASTS is not likely to cover basic external costs like travel or accommodation for the project leader. An initial study was conducted across parts of Indonesia in November 2014 identifying a number of issues under the leadership of the Indonesian Highway Institute. Like many transport problems, livestock transport involves a multitude of stakeholders and unless they all get included to look at a transition programme, not much progress can be made. It would though be interesting to identify whether places like Malaysia, Thailand, Laos, Cambodia and Vietnam experience the same issues – which would be the next step. At this stage basic funding is required to identify the basics across these countries before a larger cooperation project can be embarked on. While this may never have been raised so far, it would be good for EASTS to join other bigger organisations to perhaps have better access to external funding. Hence my proposal to see whether EASTS could join the OECD run ITF (International Transport Forum) group. There is an increased number of large transport corporates who are part of ITF that may take an interest in certain types of research in transportation.

EASTS NZ accepted to represent EASTS Australia at the CEBU conference, especially chairing the top poster and top presentation award. This will be done jointly with the support of the EASTS secretary and the help of other professors.

What next?

- Review of EASTS NZ advisory board (currently under-way)
- Updating NZ IRG proposal should Indonesia and other countries be interested and review where funding could be obtained to get the basic overview under-way.
- EASTS internship programme – how could we get it started? Development of a basic application template, model... who will be the partners (academia, companies) funding available?
- EASTS third Transport Forum Tauranga in conjunction with CILT
- Liaison with ASEAN NZ past president (under-way) & NZ industry/government leaders & seeking sponsors to cover operational costs
- Creation of web presence under EASTS Japan website (with support of EASTS secretariat – to be discussed with EASTS secretariat during conference)
- Attract new valuable members and retaining existing members by providing value to them
- Identifying the value of EASTS becoming a member of ITF (International Transport Forum)

I wish to thank my colleagues on the advisory board and special thanks go to David Kriel first Vice-president, Daniel Silva second Vice-president, Dave Stewart –EASTS NZ finance, Chris Kissling past president of EASTS NZ and David Catty, past president of ASEAN NZ, considering how EASTS NZ and ASEAN NZ could be associated.
