Academic or practical papers will be peer-reviewed for publication in the Asian Transport Studies (ATS) journal, the Journal of the EASTS, or the Proceedings of the EASTS. Papers selected for ATS and the Journal of the EASTS will be published on the journal's official website in 2025 or 2026 after the conference.

##### Non-Reviewed Papers:

These papers undergo a brief review for acceptance to be presented at the conference. Accepted papers will be uploaded to the ISC website but will not be included in the Proceedings of the EASTS, Journal of the EASTS, or ATS.

Clarification of EASTS Publications

#### 1. Asian Transport Studies (ATS)

Asian Transport Studies (ATS) is a peer-reviewed international open-access journal published by Elsevier starting with Volume 6 in 2020. Initially, it was published on J-STAGE

from 2010, covering Volumes 1 to 5, before transitioning to Elsevier. ATS publishes original research papers, special issue papers, and selected papers from the biennial International Conference.

ATS journal also accepts manuscripts submitted by general authors, similar to other international peer-reviewed journals. Authors may submit their manuscripts at any time. The Journal of the Eastern Asia Society for Transportation Studies (EASTS) is a peer-reviewed international open-access journal published on J-STAGE.
