## **Purpose:**

To promote the research activities of the EASTS by encouraging international cooperative research.

## **Requirements:**

The members of the research group should be composed of EASTS Regular Member researchers from two or more countries/areas. Grantees are expected to present the results in a special session of the 7<sup>th</sup> EASTS in 2007.

## **Evaluation Criteria:**

- Internationality
  - Whether the members consist of multiple countries/areas.
- Academic/Practical Novelty
  - Whether the research has enough academic/practical novelty, “novelty” includes the comparison with past ICRA researches.
- Usefulness
- Prospect
