

Evaluation Criteria:

- Internationality
 - → Whether the members consist of multiple countries/areas.
- Academic/Practical Novelty
 - → Whether the research has enough academic/practical novelty, "novelty" includes the comparison with past ICRA researches.
- Usefulness
- Prospect
