The 12th Malaysian Universities Transport Research Forum Conference (MUTRFC) was held on 10th – 12th October 2017 at UiTM Shah Alam, Selangor, Malaysia. It was also held in conjunction with the 4th Asian-German Knowledge for Logistics (AGKN) on Tour event. The theme of our MUTRFC was “Smart lifestyle through innovative transportation mobility”
