


ATS has been included in Scopus.

International Research Group (IRG)


IRG aims;

- ✓ Promote International Research Activities
- ✓ Conduct symposia, seminars and workshops
- ✓ Activate young researchers of EASTS
 - ➤ Starting in 2005
 - Call for new IRGs in every year
 - ➤ Including members from <u>at least three domestic societies</u>
 - > IRG is eligible for ICRA research grant
 - Total 50 + 3 IRGs were formed (11 IRGs are ongoing)
 - Publish papers as Special Issues in ATS

Research Grant: International Cooperative Research Activities (ICRA)

IRG is eligible for ICRA grant

Type of grant	Research period	Maximum amount of grant
ICRA-A (ICRA for incubating research)	2 years	USD 10,000 for two years
ICRA-B (ICRA for publicity of achievement)	1 year	USD 5,000 for one year


- ✓ [Selection Criteria] "Internationality", "Academic/Practical Novelty", "Usefulness" and "Prospect", "Past Achievements", "Validity of Expense", and "Feasibility".
- ✓ ICRA applications are evaluated by the ICRA Selection Committee organized by EASTS-Japan.



Incentives for Young Researchers: Financial Support

- ✓ EASTS provides financial support to the qualified presenters (mainly young researchers in developing countries) (registration fee, airfare and accommodation fees).
- ✓ The following conditions should be satisfied to qualify;
 - EASTS regular members
 - Presenters of reviewed paper
 - Belonging to the EASTS member domestic societies in developing countries.
 - Application for financial support must be submitted.
- √ 50-70 young researchers of developing countries receive the EASTS support in recent conferences
